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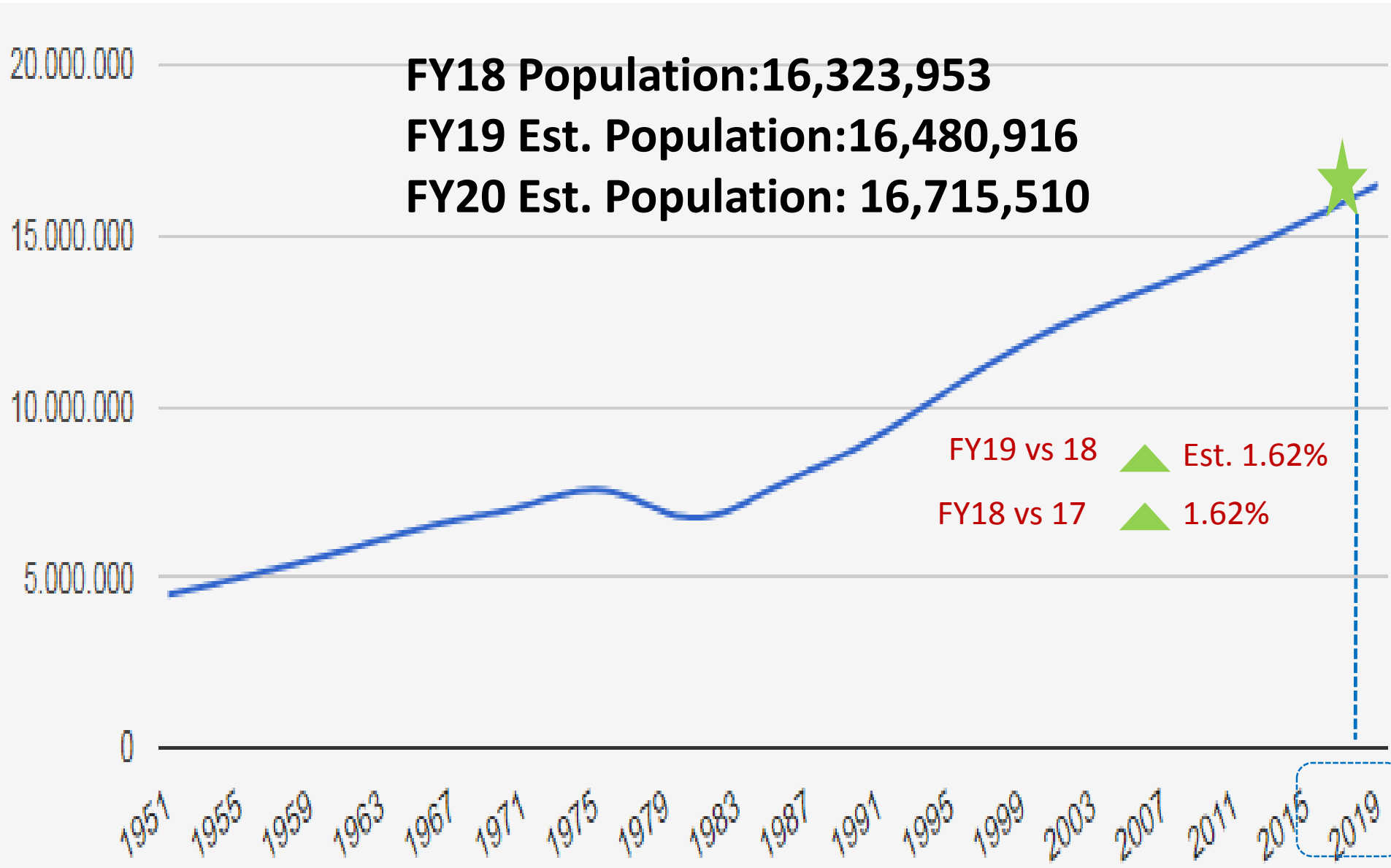

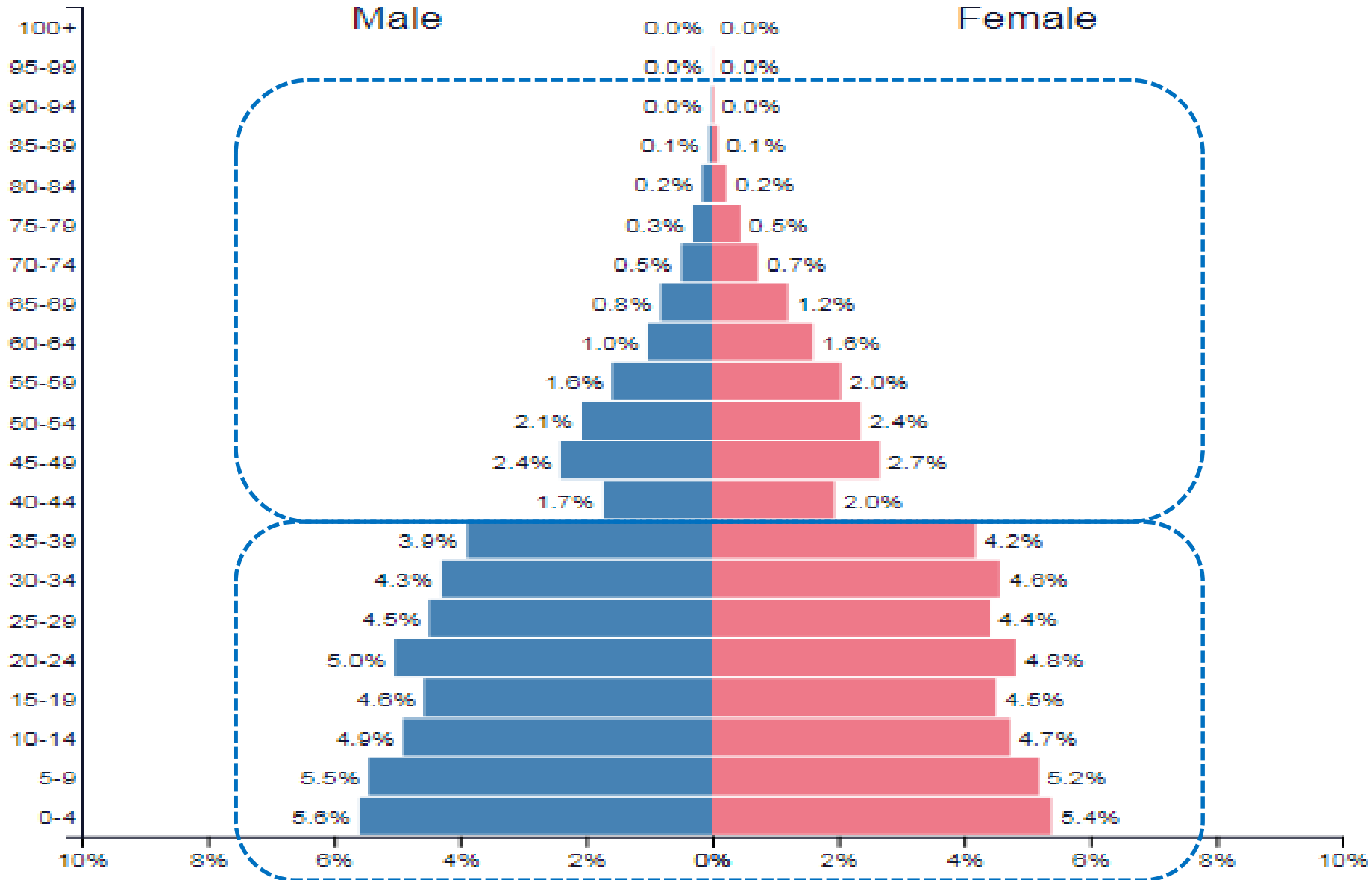

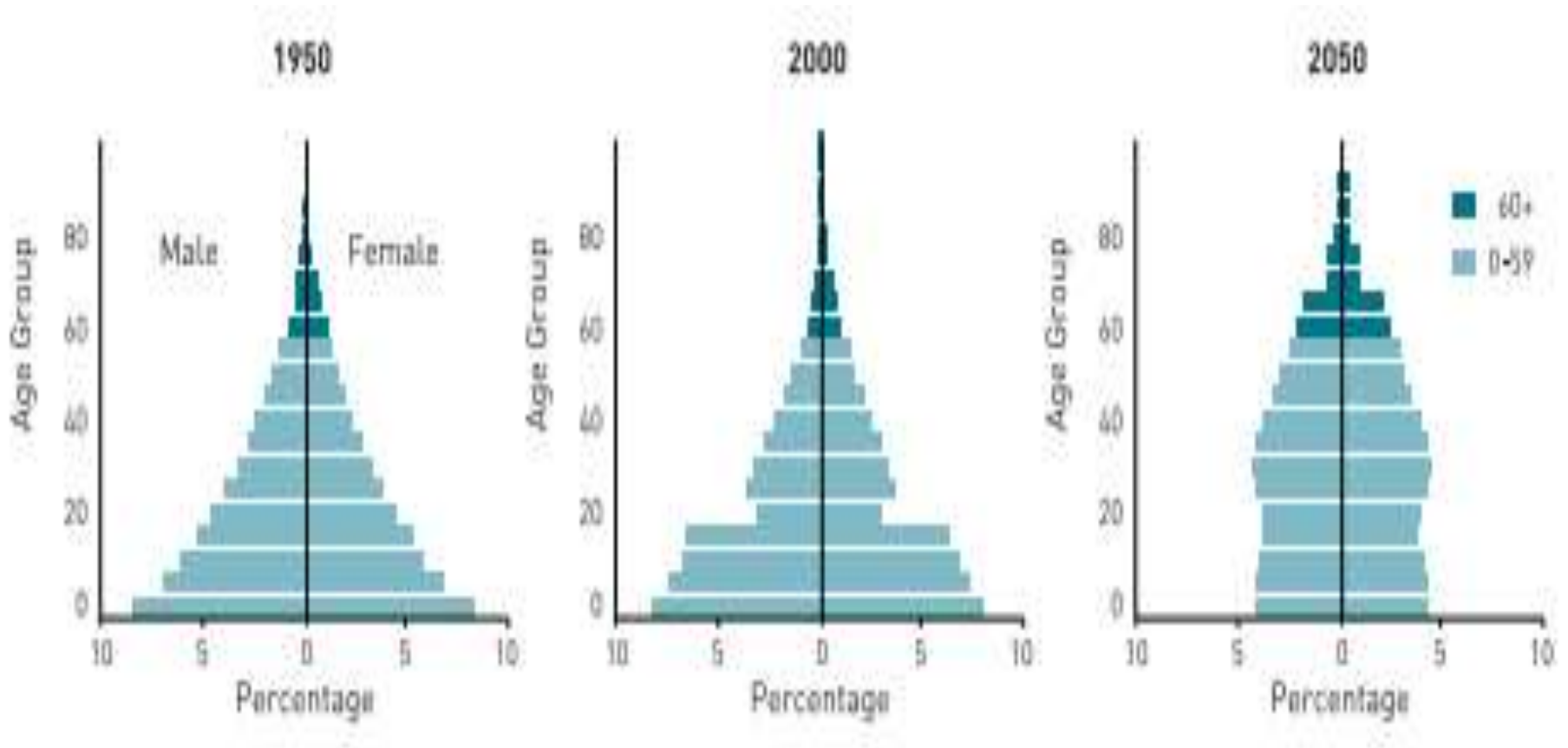

II. Population Pyramid



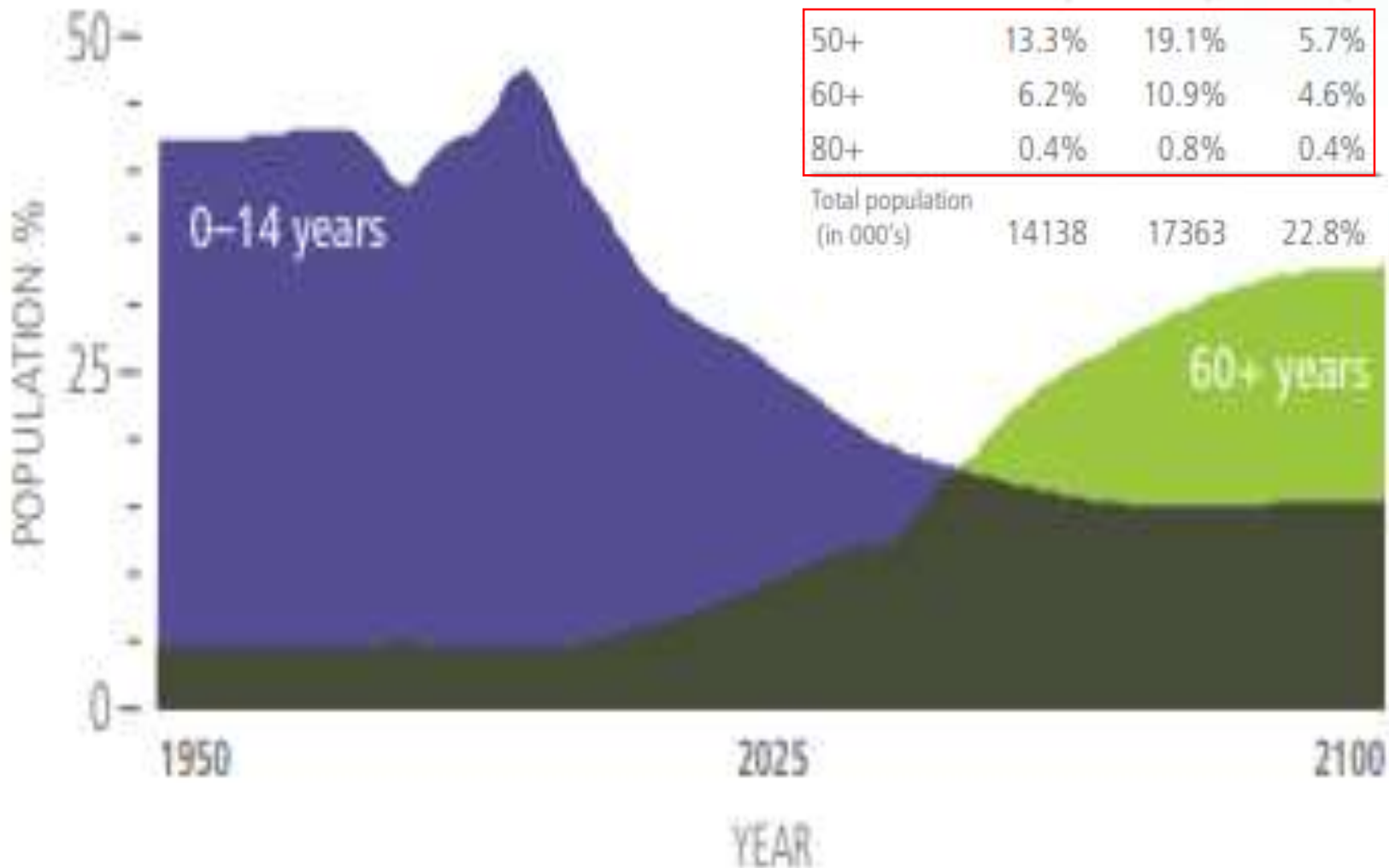

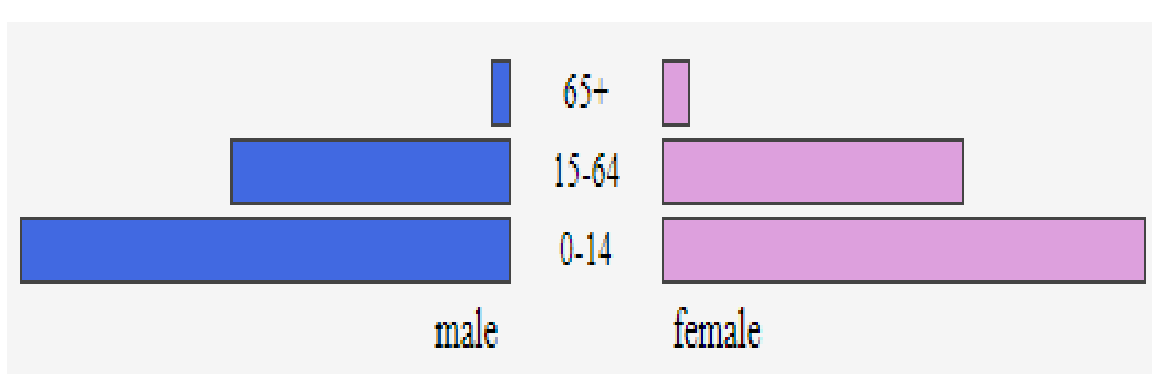

- Health quality is rising along with Cambodia growing economy, with a steadily rising life expectancy



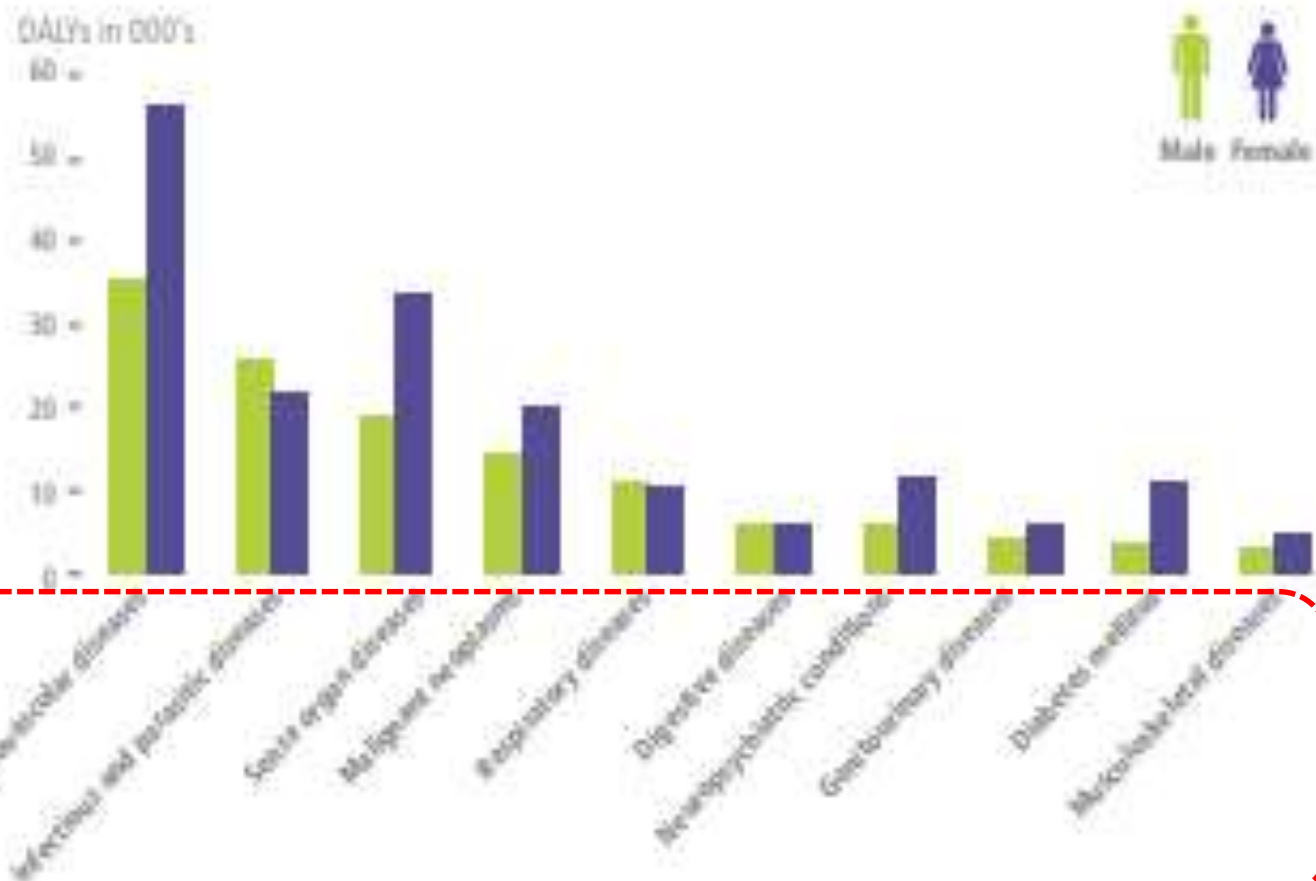

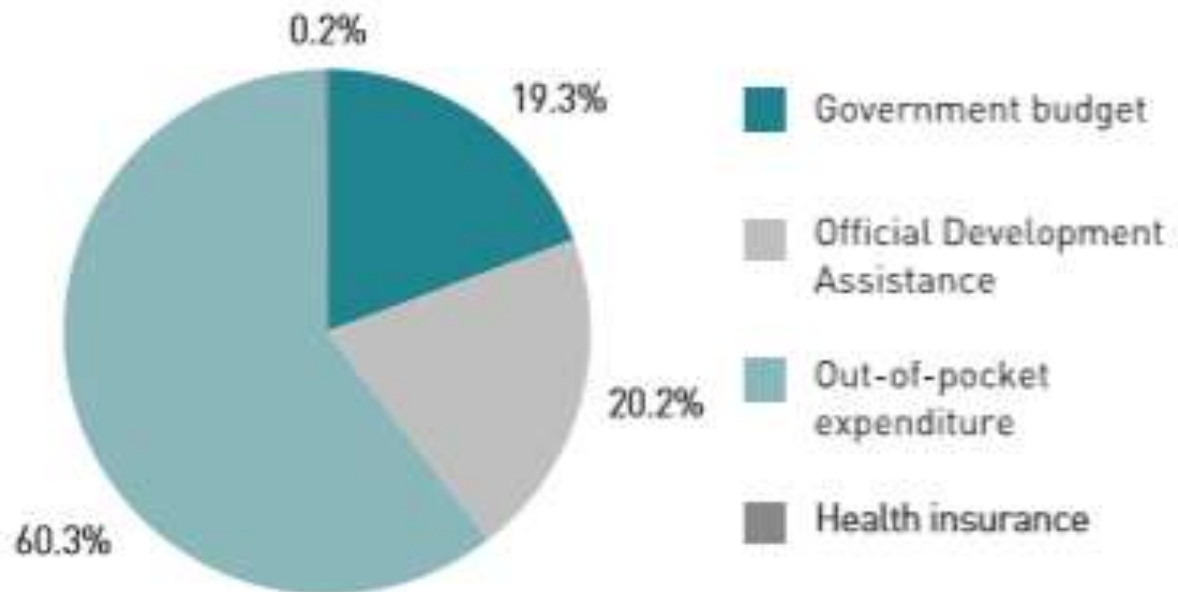
